MARQUIS BANK NAMES JAVIER J. HOLTZ CHAIRMAN AND CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

North Miami Beach, Fla. – The Board of Directors of North Miami Beach-based Marquis Bank has named Javier J. Holtz chairman and CEO. Holtz, a Miami banking veteran, brings more than 20 years of community and regional bank experience to the \$64 million institution. He spent 15 years at Capital Bank (Miami, FL) and seven years in senior executive positions at Regions Bank and its predecessor, Union Planters Bank.

Holtz began his career at Capital Bank in 1983 and served in various positions, including assistant vice president and lending officer, commercial relationship manager and regional manager, overseeing a group of retail banking centers. In 1992, he was named senior vice president and assistant division manager for domestic lending where he oversaw all domestic lending activities of the bank, including small and middle-market lending, commercial banking and consumer lending together with the special assets function. In 1994, he was appointed executive vice president and chief credit officer responsible for asset quality of the \$2 billion bank and its wholly-owned commercial finance company, Capital Factors, Inc.

When Capital Bank was acquired by Union Planters Corporation (Memphis, TN) in 1998, Holtz was named executive vice president and chief credit officer for the Bank's Florida franchise which grew to \$5 billion in assets as a result of a number of subsequent acquisitions. By 2001, he was promoted to regional senior credit officer with overall asset quality responsibility for the southern region's \$8 billion in assets.

In 2003, Holtz was named president of Capital Factors, Inc., a \$3 billion multi-state commercial finance operation with more than 360 associates. He stepped down from his position when it was sold to a New York-based private equity firm in 2005.

Since 2005, Holtz operated a private equity firm which invested in real estate and middle market companies. He has served on the Village of Indian Creek council since 2008 and currently serves as vice mayor of the council.

“We are extremely pleased to bring someone with Javier’s experience and track record to lead Marquis Bank. He has demonstrated outstanding leadership and banking skills throughout his 20-plus year career,” said Jeffrey Perlow. Perlow, a partner in the law firm of Fromberg, Perlow, and Kornik, P.A., was one of the original founders of the bank and serves as a member of the Board of Directors and Executive Committee.

Holtz graduated from George Washington University with a bachelor’s degree from the School of Government and Business Administration. He is 49 years old, married, and the father of three children. He and his wife, Andria, dedicate their time to the Diabetes Research Institute Foundation, Holtz Children’s Hospital at Jackson Memorial, Miami Country Day School, and Mt. Sinai Hospital.
